NOTES:

All records received up to the end of 1991 are included on the following maps. These records are mainly derived (with the notable exception of *Acheta domestica*) from observations in the period 1983-1991. There is little historical information available in the literature, details are provided in the Bibliography. Dots included on the maps are not, therefore, divided into date-classes, although the vast majority refer to the modern period of recording and the current known status of each species effectively corresponds to that depicted. The exception to this is the house cricket *A. domestica*, which has not been recorded in Ceredigion since 1966.

In addition, there have been two reports of common cockroach *Blatta orientalis* (both in 1960) and two records of Australian cockroach *Periplaneta australasiae* (both in 1986).







COMMON FIELD GRASSHOPPER




**Chorthippus parallelus**  
MEADOW GRASSHOPPER




**Myrmeleotettix maculatus**  
MOTTLED GRASSHOPPER




*Omocestus viridulus*  
COMMON GREEN GRASSHOPPER




**Tetrix undulata**  
COMMON GROUNDHOPPER




*Conocephalus dorsalis*  
SHORT-WINGED CONEHEAD




**Leptophyes punctatissima**  
SPECKLED BUSH-CRICKET







**Meconema thalassinum**  
OAK BUSH-CRICKET




*Metrioptera brachyptera*
